Things everyone needs to know

Autumn is the time for harvest. Temperatures begin to drop and birds migrate. Leaves fall from trees.

Winter is the coldest time of year with severe weather . Some animals hibernate.

In the spring, the temperature starts to rise again and flowers begin to grow. Some baby animals are born.

Summer is the hottest season and flowers and trees are in full bloom.

The longest day of the year (Summer Solstice) in the UK falls on the 21st June.

During the Spring an Autumn Equinox, there is an equal amount of daylight and night.
